**Resolution to Extend the Borough of Tatamy's State of  
Emergency in response to the COVID-19 Pandemic**

**WHEREAS**, as the COVID-19 Pandemic threatens to cause injury, damage, and sufferings to the persons and property of the Borough of Tatamy; and

**WHEREAS**, Emergency Management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of residents in the Borough of Tatamy; and


**WHEREAS**, a State of Emergency has been declared by the President of the United States, and the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania due to the COVID-19 Pandemic; and


**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, Mayor Christopher Moren, in conjunction with the Council, declared a local Emergency Declaration to be effective immediately which would expire in 7 days; and

**WHEREAS**, Title 35 Health and Safety, Part 5 Emergency Management Services, Chapter 75 Section 7501 (b) requires the governing body of a political subdivision to authorize the continuation of the Emergency Declaration as issued by the mayor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Borough of Tatamy wishes to extend the Emergency Declaration in the Borough of Tatamy until concurrent State of Emergency Status is rescinded by the United States of America, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and the County of Northampton;


