Traffic Notification – Phase 2 Crossover / SR 33 NB

Dear Stakeholder,

The purpose of this letter is to inform local municipalities, emergency service providers, businesses, and community organizations of upcoming traffic pattern changes on SR 33 between the Tatamy and Stockertown interchanges.

As you may have noticed, dynamic message signs on southbound SR 33 are currently notifying motorists of a new traffic pattern beginning June 8. Please be advised that this change consists only of a minor shift of the existing two travel lanes towards the right shoulder. No significant impacts to traffic are anticipated beyond temporary single-lane closures during nighttime hours on June 8, 9, and 10 to facilitate the traffic shift.

The primary traffic change associated with this project will be a long-term traffic restriction on northbound SR 33. Between the Tatamy and Stockertown interchanges, the existing two northbound travel lanes will be reduced to a single lane. This traffic configuration will allow vehicles to be diverted through a median crossover and around the Bushkill Creek Bridge, which is scheduled for demolition and reconstruction.

The anticipated date for implementation of this traffic switch is July 10. Some project message boards have previously displayed June 18 as the anticipated date, however, those signs have been updated to reflect the revised schedule. Based on feedback received from the local community and project stakeholders, it was determined that implementing this restriction immediately before the Independence Day holiday would create unnecessary impacts to the traveling public.

The anticipated duration of the northbound lane restriction is approximately five weeks, from July 10 through August 16. During this period, the northbound SR 33 entrance ramp from Tatamy and the northbound SR 33 exit ramp to Stockertown will also be closed. For your reference, a copy of the proposed detour plan is attached.
